<b>Sorting</b>	Successive (manual and optical/floating sorting)
<b>Winemaking</b>	In stainless steel tanks
<b>Blend</b>	62 % Cabernet Sauvignon, 38 % Merlot,
<b>Degree</b>	13 % vol
<b>Yield</b>	46 hl/ha
<b>Harvests</b>	From September 12 <sup>th</sup> to 28 <sup>th</sup>
<b>Ageing</b>	15 months in oak barrels (15% new)
<b>Bottling</b>	From April 22 <sup>nd</sup> to May 3 <sup>rd</sup>
